FDA: Quality considerations for continuous manufacturing

The comment period ended on 28 May 2019 for the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) draft guidance on what factors brand and generic drug manufacturers should consider when setting up and using a continuous manufacturing system to produce their products. The guidance outlines the benefits of continuous manufacturing over traditional batch manufacturing, including the efficiency that comes with continuous manufacturing that could eventually lead to lower drug prices for consumers.
